#### Ticket Sales:

#### - Early Bird: \$95 from February 18th - 28th

- Regular: \$105 from March 2nd April 9th
- Last-Minute: \$115 from April 14th May 1st
- There is a payment plan available in which students can pay a \$60 deposit and then pay in installments until the ticket is paid off. The total price of the ticket is dependent on which time frame you finish the payment within. If your last instalment is paid during the 'last-minute' time frame, the 'last-minute' price will be the cost of the ticket. This is available to all students.
- Tickets will be sold outside of the parent forum!

Students are permitted to bring a plus one to prom! If they are a high school student, forms may be picked up for them and their school's VP to sign.
