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1. Donation of used Uniform Pieces to The School (message from: David)

As I the past, UFA will gladly accept used uniform items that families wish to donate to the school. As you prepare to return to UFA to pick up your personal belongings and return your textbooks, we will have a large bin in the Parent Forum (2^{nd} Floor) where you can drop of the pieces. If you could wash the pieces before returning them to the school that would be an extra benefit the school would appreciate.

2. Student Access Protocol Summarized (Please refer to the Thursday, June 5, NewsFlash for the Complete Protocol (message from: Access Protocol Cmt)

We hope that you are all doing well. This item summarizes the procedure for students to access their lockers to retrieve personal belongings and to return their textbooks and athletic Uniforms that was sent out yesterday. Please note that the primary focus of the Protocol is to ensure the safety of students and teachers throughout the process. So please follow the procedures summarized below.

- a. Students will have 15 minutes to empty their lockers and return their textbooks and athletic uniforms
- b. Students will need to wear a mask (or some sort of face-covering) while they are in the building
- c. Students are asked to bring a bag large enough to hold all of the contents of their locker (we will have some large garbage bags available for those who do not have one). As the amount of time students have in the building is limited (15 minutes) Students should not be sorting their locker items at school, all personal items should be placed in the bag and sorted at home. Only perishable items should be disposed of at school in the garbage cans that are provided
- d. Students must practice physical distancing at all times (keep a minimum of 2 metres from others).
- e. Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance and exit
- f. The Library, Cafeteria, Drama Room, Gymnasium and the Main Office will not be accessible. Students please restrict your movement in the building to accessing your locker and returning textbooks etc. to the designated drop of areas.
- ^{g.} Parents and/or other drivers the underground parking lot will not be available. Since each group will range in size from 15-17 students, we are assuming that there will be sufficient parking on the side streets to allow for the short access period the student is in the building

3. Access Schedule by Grade (message from: Access Protocol Cmt)

To ensure we maintain the required social distancing and conform to the Guidelines for a Structure the size of UFA – specific appointments are being developed. Each student will receive a personalized email starting next week with their appointment date and time. Due to the limitations on the number of people we are allowed to have in the school at once – we have to insist that you respect the schedule that was developed.
