## 1. Engagement in Remote Learning Update (message from: Barb)

This week staff undertook a process similar to our in person grade meetings as a way of determining engagement in school. While we are happy to report that the majority of students are engaged we did note a few students who are not engaging in remote learning and we recognize that this may not be possible for them at this time. This led us into discussions about how to refine a re-engagement process that encourages students to engage in remote learning in a way that is manageable for them and does not leave them feeling overwhelmed with what they may have missed.

With this in mind, we encourage parents and students to have an honest conversation about their mental health, their progress in and engagement with remote learning and to reach out to the school if there are any questions or concerns. We will continue to reach out to families to help create a plan that is manageable for the student, which would allow for success, and create a more solid foundation for next year. We are asking that parents work with us to determine what level of engagement is possible for their children at this time while keeping health and well-being at the forefront.
