Nov 22: Grade 12 Society: Challenge & Change In-School Field Trip

Students in *Grade 12 Society: Challenge & Change* were visited by Toronto Star reporter Sara Mojtehdzadeh as part of their exploration of the intersections of power, ideology and the workplace in Ontario, 2019. In 2017, Sara went undercover at a bakery in Mississauga, Fiera Foods, to investigate why temporary workers there were dying on the job (read more about it here: <https://projects.thestar.com/temp-employment-agencies/>). Sara's visit helped contextualize some of the concerning trends in working realities in Ontario right now; afterwards, students expressed that hearing about Sara's experiences directly from her brought the issue to life for them. Challenge & Change is a new course offering at UFA. Students in the course develop a critical economic literacy, intersectional lens foundation and praxis that enables them to engage with the roots of injustice, and build a world that reflects their goals & values. *Organized by Seth.*
